Is it mandatory? Yes. The only exceptions are people who have taken an Ethics course since June 2014 OR are currently teaching a university level Ethics course. For exemption, proof of completion must be sent to our Registrar at info@cctnb.ca or the address below.

Unable to attend? If you are unable to attend, please advise our Registrar by Oct. 20. Absent members not exempt as above will be required to take an Ethics workshop in October 2018 or acceptable to the Board by Dec. 2018.

A *Certificate of Completion* will be provided to all members who complete the workshop.
